About College

Our Journey and Growth

Government Medical College, Bhavnagar was established on April 29, 1995, with an initial capacity of 50 students. We've grown steadily over the years, increasing our annual admissions to 100, then 150, and since 2019, we now proudly admit 200 students each year.

Our postgraduate programs began in 2002 with 12 seats across six subjects. Today, we offer PG courses in all 20 subjects, with a total of 136 postgraduate seats (133 for degrees and 3 for diplomas).

Sir Takhtsinhji General Hospital: Our Legacy of Care

Sir Takhtsinhji General Hospital, affectionately known as Sir T Hospital, is our teaching hospital. Since its establishment in 1933, it has served not only Bhavnagar but also three neighboring districts.

With the hospital's affiliation with our college, its capacity has expanded to 1,030 teaching beds, managing an average of over 1,800 outpatients daily. We also provide crucial care to the residents of Alang, home to Asia's largest shipbreaking yard.

Our doctors and paramedics have been instrumental in serving the community during numerous natural disasters and epidemics. To support our future growth, the institute has also acquired two large plots of land in Nari and Ruva, Bhavnagar.

Modernizing Our Facilities

Sir T Hospital, which is **NABH (Entry-level) and Laqshya accredited**, features multiple specialized buildings, including:

- Old palatial hospital building, Gopnath Maternity Home, Pediatric Ward building
- Various OPD and ward buildings for different specialties like Skin, Surgery, Orthopedics, Medicine, Ophthalmology, and Dentistry. A Trauma Center for emergency services, Respiratory Medicine ward, Burn ward, Laboratory building, Hostels for both undergraduate and postgraduate students are located on the hospital campus.

The New Superspecialty Hospital

We are proud to announce that a new superspecialty hospital, built with a grant from the **PMSSY Phase 4** program, is now complete and will be inaugurated soon. This state-of-the-art facility will house six superspecialty departments: Neurology, Neurosurgery, Cardiology, Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery, Nephrology, and Urology.

It will be equipped with modern amenities like modular operation theaters, a building management system, sewage and effluent treatment plants, central air conditioning, ICUs, HDUs, and wards with Medical Gas Pipeline Systems (MGPS). The hospital will also feature the latest equipment, including a **3 Tesla MRI, 128-slice CT scan machine, Cathlab, and lithotripsy**. The Government of Gujarat plans to introduce superspecialty courses in these departments once they are functional.

Advanced Technology and Learning

Our commitment to excellence extends to our technology and academic resources:

- **Medical Technology:** We have a state-of-the-art ART center and a Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy Chamber.
- **Accreditation:** All our laboratories and blood bank are **NABL and NABH accredited**, respectively, ensuring the highest standards of quality.
- **E-Learning:** We have a well-established e-learning laboratory, a Learning Management System (LMS), Hospital Management Information System (HMIS), and a videoconferencing system.
- **Connectivity:** We have **National Knowledge Network (NKN)** connectivity to every department, library, and lecture hall, running on a dedicated network at a speed of 100 Mbps.

A Note on Hostels and Campus Life

We understand that a comfortable and secure living environment is essential for your academic success. Here's what you need to know about our hostel and campus facilities. Currently, we provide separate hostel accommodations for our male and female students:

- For Boys: Four hostels for undergraduate and intern students.
- For Girls: 40 quarters in the D block, 7 quarters in the E block, and 13 rooms in the Nursing Hostel for interns.
- Mess facilities for all undergraduate hostels, with separate arrangements for postgraduate students.
- Pure Drinking Water: R.O. systems and water coolers.
- Hot Water: Solar heaters and geysers.

- Sports: Facilities for indoor games like table tennis and outdoor games.

Our Zero-Tolerance Policy on Ragging

We are committed to providing a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all students. To ensure this, we maintain a strict **zero-tolerance policy** against ragging.

What is Ragging?

Ragging is any disorderly conduct, whether spoken, written, or physical, that has the effect of:

- Teasing, treating with rudeness, or causing annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm to any other student, especially a junior or fresher.
- Engaging in rowdy or undisciplined activities that create a sense of fear or embarrassment.
- Forcing a student to perform an act that they would not normally do, which adversely affects their physical or mental well-being.

Punishments for Ragging

Depending on the nature and severity of the offense, anyone found guilty of ragging will face one or more of the following punishments, as determined by the Anti-Ragging Committee:

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from classes.
3. Withholding or withdrawal of scholarships and other benefits.
4. Debarment from appearing in any exams or evaluation processes.
5. Withholding of results.
6. Debarment from representing the Institute in any event.
7. Suspension or expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the Institute for a period of 1 to 4 semesters.
9. Expulsion from the Institute and debarment from admission to any other institution.
10. A fine of ₹25,000.
11. **Collective Punishment:** If the individuals responsible for ragging cannot be identified, a collective punishment may be imposed on the community to ensure accountability.

બોન્ડ સોલવંશી/ બેંક ગેરંટી (બોન્ડ રૂ.૧૦ લાખ)

- (૧) બોન્ડ સોલવંશીમાં રૂ. ૧૦,૦૦,૦૦૦/-થી ઉપરની માર્કેટ વેલ્યુ ધરાવતી હોય તેવી મિલકતની બોન્ડ સોલવંશી આપવાની રહેશે.
- (૨) બોન્ડ સોલવંશીમાં જે જામીનદાર(સ્યોરીટી) રહેલ હોય તેના આધાર કાર્ડ અને લાઇટબીલની નકલ જોડવાની રહેશે.

Library Rules & Regulations

Welcome to the Dhanvantary Granthalaya! Our library is a vital resource for all students and staff. To ensure a productive and respectful environment, please adhere to the following rules and regulations.

General Conduct & Access

- **Eligibility:** All students and staff are entitled to use the library facilities.
 - **Silence:** Absolute silence is expected inside the library at all times. All conversations, discussions, phone calls, and any form of loud communication are strictly prohibited.
 - **Prohibited Items:** Personal belongings like books, bags, and briefcases are not allowed in the stack room. Please leave them at the reception counter.
 - **Entry & Exit:** All visitors must sign the register with the correct time upon entering and leaving the library.
 - **Library Hours:** The library is open from **10:00 AM to 6:00 PM** on weekdays and from **8:00 AM to 2:00 PM** on Saturdays. It is closed on Sundays and public holidays.
 - **Reading Rooms:** One reading room at interns' hostel for boys and one reading room at D Quarter (Girl's hostel) & adjacent to the library with a seating capacity of 250 will start in one month in the university campus. (*Chanakya Kaksha*).
 - **Computers:** Library computers are for academic use only. Accessing unauthorized websites, playing games, or chatting is strictly prohibited. Do not tamper with any equipment and report any issues to the staff on duty.
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Borrowing & Fines

- **Library Membership:** You must have a library account to borrow books. Please fill out the membership form and submit the required documents to get your account.
 - **Identity:** Always carry your College ID card and library account number. Books will not be issued without them.
 - **Late Fees:** Books must be returned by the due date. A fine of **₹1 per day** will be charged for the first month. The fine increases to **₹2 per day** for the second month and **₹3 per day** for the third month and so on until the cost of the book is recovered. You will receive a government receipt for all fines paid.
 - **Renewals:** You cannot renew a book with the same accession number. If multiple copies are available, you can return the book and borrow a different copy.
 - **Lost or Damaged Books:** If you lose or damage a book, you must notify the librarian immediately. You will be required to replace the book with the same or a newer edition. If the book is out of print, you will have to pay the full cost, as determined by the librarian and the Dean.
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General Conduct & Accountability

- **Care of Materials:** Do not tear pages, underline, or write on any books or journals. Please handle all library property with care.
- **Furniture:** Do not deface or damage any library furniture.
- **Forfeiture:** Disregarding any of these rules may result in the forfeiture of your library privileges.
- **No Dues Certificate:** All students and staff must obtain a "No Due Certificate" from the librarian before leaving the institution. This is a mandatory requirement.

Hostel Rules & Regulations

Welcome to the Government Medical College hostels. These rules are in place to ensure a safe, clean, and respectful environment for everyone. Please read them carefully.

Admission and Fees

1. **Local Students:** Local students are not permitted to stay in the college hostels.
 2. **Application:** Students seeking admission must contact the hostel office for boys or girls separately.
 3. **Allotment:** Room and hostel allotments are at the discretion of the concerned authorities. You are not allowed to change your room without their prior permission.
 4. **Submission:** Hostel admission forms are available on the college website (www.bvnmedicol.org). Please fill out the form and submit it on orientation day at the designated counter.
 5. **Fees:** Hostel fees must be paid before the term begins. A late fee of 10% will be charged for delays up to ten days. If fees remain unpaid after ten days, your hostel admission will be canceled, and you will not be permitted to attend classes.
 6. **Security Deposit:** A refundable deposit of ₹2,500 must be paid upon admission. This deposit will be used to cover any damages you cause to hostel property. If the deposit is not claimed within one month of leaving the hostel, it will be forfeited.
 7. **Re-admission:** Re-admission and room re-allotment (if necessary) are required annually upon payment of hostel fees.
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General Rules of Stay

1. **Unauthorized Occupancy:** You must reside in your allotted room. Anyone found accommodating unauthorized guests or occupying a room other than their own will face disciplinary action.
2. **Absence:** Your hostel admission will be canceled if you are found to have temporary accommodation outside the hostel, are continuously absent for a long period, or do not stay in your allotted room. In such cases, your fees and deposit will be forfeited, and you will not be given hostel accommodation in the future.
3. **Visitors:** Outside students, guests, or visitors of the opposite gender are not allowed in your room. They must be received in the designated visitor's room. Guests are not permitted to stay overnight; unauthorized stays will result in punitive action.
4. **Vacations:** You are not allowed to stay in the hostel during vacations. Rooms must be vacated after annual exams to allow for maintenance and to save electricity. Keys must be submitted to the hostel superintendent or clerk. If you need to stay during a vacation for a valid reason, you must get prior permission from the concerned authority.
5. **Leaving Campus:** If you need to go out of town, you must get prior permission. Being absent for more than two weekdays without a valid reason will result in disciplinary action.
6. **Cleanliness and Property:**
 - You must maintain cleanliness in and around your room and the hostel premises.
 - Littering outside of designated bins will result in a fine.
 - You will be held responsible for any damage to your room's furniture and fittings.
 - Do not use electrical appliances such as heaters, irons, air conditioners, or induction plates. They will be confiscated, and you will face punitive action.
 - Report any damage to common areas immediately.

7. **Prohibited Items:** The possession or consumption of alcohol, narcotics, psychotropic substances, or any illegal implements is strictly forbidden. Anyone found in possession of these substances or items will be expelled from the hostel and may face legal action.
 8. **Ragging:** Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action.
 9. **Security:** You are responsible for your own valuables. Avoid keeping large amounts of cash or expensive items. Report any theft to the warden.
 10. **Behavior:** Meetings, functions, and loud music are not allowed. You must treat hostel employees with respect. Do not engage in disputes or fights.
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Mess Rules

1. The mess is under the authority of the Dean.
 2. Mess accounts are managed by the mess contractor.
 3. If you fail to pay your mess bill, you will not be allowed to use the mess facilities. You must clear all dues by the end of the term, or your deposit and exam results will be withheld.
 4. Food is not allowed to be carried out of the mess. You must eat all meals in the dining hall.
 5. Tiffin services from private vendors are not permitted.
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Special Rules and Disciplinary Actions

1. **Visiting Hours:**
 - Monday to Saturday: 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
 - Sunday: 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM
2. **Curfew:** You must be inside the hostel by 9:30 PM. No one will be allowed to enter after this time without prior permission. You are also not permitted to leave the hostel before 5:30 AM/6:00 AM without a valid reason.
3. **Late Night Permissions:** Prior permission is required for staying out late. If you need to be out past 11:00 PM, you must have a written recommendation from your parents or local guardian.
4. **Local Guardian:** Your parents must approve your local guardian, and you must provide their address and phone number on the hostel admission form.
