## Annexure – one 9.5. Learner-doctor method of clinical training (clinical clerkship) as GME 2019

9.5.1 **Goal**: To provide learners with experience in:

- (a) Longitudinal patient care
- (b) Being part of the health care team
- (c) Hands-on care of patients in outpatient and inpatient setting

## 9.5.2 Structure:

- (a) The first clinical posting in second professional shall orient learners to the patient, their roles and the specialty.
- (b) The learner-doctor programme will progress as below mentioned table.
- (c) The learner will function as a part of the health care team with the following responsibilities:
  - (i) Be part of the unit's outpatient services on admission days.
  - (ii) Be part of the unit's indoor patient services during posting.
  - (iii) Be assigned to patients admitted during each admission day for whom he/she will undertake
  - responsibility, under the supervision of a senior resident or faculty member.
  - (iv) Participate in the unit rounds and will present the assigned patients to the supervising physician.
  - (v) Follow the patient's progress throughout the hospital stay until discharge.
  - (vi) Participate, under supervision, in procedures, surgeries, deliveries etc. of assigned patients
  - (vii) Discuss ethical and other humanitarian issues during unit rounds.
  - (viii) Attend all scheduled classes and educational activities.
  - (ix) Document his/her observations in a prescribed log book / case record.
